One entry per person per category

All exhibits must be brought to the Art Hall on Monday evening July 20, 2009, 6:00 p.m.- 8:00 p.m. or by 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 21. Judging time is 10:00 a.m.

Superintendents, in each department may use their own discretion in handling entries on entry day and day of removal.

All Blue Ribbon Winners will be considered for sweepstakes offered, without making entry.

Articles receiving blue ribbons may NOT be re-entered the next year.

Due to lack of space elaborate displays will not be allowed. Small cards with information such as use, age, etc. will be permitted.

Qualified judges will be obtained and their decisions are final
