2010 MISS MACOUPIN COUNTY JR MISS OFFICAL RULES

1. Minimum of 12 years of age but not 15 years of age by the date of the pageant – must have completed the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade, but not have begun high school.
2. Contestants must provide a copy of birth certificate
3. Single female contestants only, not marries and never pregnant
4. Resident of Macoupin County or attended a Macoupin County School for a minimum of 6 months
5. US Citizen with no felonies
6. Agrees to be judged in: personal interview, sportswear and a party dress
7. Clothes, hair, and make up must be approved prior to pageant by pageant director or her appointee
8. Decision of the judges are final- no exceptions
9. \$10 entry fee paid before 1st practice
10. One ear piercing at pageant, other earrings must be removed. Any tattoos must be covered.
11. New Jr. Miss will serve as Jr. Hostess to the 2010 Macoupin County Fair; the 2010 Miss Macoupin County Fair Queen will serve as the Official Hostess.
12. All appearances as the Jr. Miss must be approved by the pageant director or her appointee. The Jr. Miss will be responsible for securing a convertible for parades, etc.
13. If the 2010 Jr. Miss cannot fulfill her duties, she will relinquish her title, crown and all prizes to the 1st runner-up.
14. Good conduct throughout the practices and reign is expected; bad conduct by any contestant or their family will result in disqualification form the pageant.
15. A responsible parent or guardian must attend a meeting with pageant director to review and sign the official consent form to become the 2010 Jr. Miss contestant.
16. We look forward to welcoming the 1st 15 contestants to our pageant and promise an opportunity of a lifetime for each contestant.
