## MACOUPIN COUNTY JUNIOR AUCTION RULES

1. The Macoupin County Junior Auction is for Macoupin County Juniors only.
2. Macoupin Juniors can only sell (1) animal.  
No animals are allowed to sell, such as sows, boars, ewes, rams, cows or bulls
3. The only eligible sale division will be: Beef, Swine, and Sheep  
Sale order will be decided by the Superintendent
4. All large animals must be weighed prior to the sale at the designated place and time
